Data Collection Survey on Gender aims to collect relevant information and analyze the current situation of gender mainstreaming and gender equality in South Sudan with a focus on women's economic empowerment. In addition to the survey, JICA, in collaboration with the Ministry of Gender, Child and Social Welfare, plans to conduct workshops on gender mainstreaming to national and state ministries. At the end of the Data Collection Survey, recommendations will be made on the possible future cooperation between JICA and the Government of South Sudan to enhance women's economic empowerment in South Sudan. Moreover, JICA, in cooperation with the Ministry of Gender, Child and Social Welfare, is raising awareness on gender equality and women's empowerment on occasions such as the International Women's Day on 8th March. JICA is also promoting gender mainstreaming in all of its projects as a cross-cutting issue.
