Project Goal: To speed up customs procedures and improve the X-ray inspection rate by installation of large-sized X-ray equipment for inspection of freight and vehicles at high-risk border check points near the neighboring countries and provision of technical training for customs officers, thereby contribute to establishment of efficient transport networks.

Total Grant Amount (Phase I) (Phase II): USD 9.4 million
