

## Project Brief

**Issue:** Agricultural Reform and Rural Development

**Scheme:** ODA Loans

**Project Title:** Amu-Bukhara Irrigation System Rehabilitation Project (UZB-P14)

**Loan Amount:** 11,872 million Japanese Yen (approximately 100 million US Dollars).



**Terms and conditions of repayment:** Interest Rate: 1.40 % p.a. (other than consulting services); 0.01 % p.a. (consulting services). Repayment Period: 30 years, including 10 years of grace period (other than consulting services)

**Uzbek Counterpart:** Ministry of Agriculture and Water Resources of Uzbekistan.

**Project Goal:** The project is co-financed with Asian Development Bank (ADB) and JICA`s part is aimed at modernization of the existing two pump stations (“Khamza-II” and “Kizil Teppa Auxiliary”) in Amu Bukhara Irrigation System

**Project Scope:**

- 1) Rehabilitation Work of Khamza-II Pumping Station;
- 2) Rehabilitation Work of Kizil Teppa Auxiliary Pumping Station; and
- 3) Consulting Services for the component of JICA’s portion (Khamza-II and Kizil Teppa Auxiliary).

**Results (Expected for on-going projects):** The project will deliver sufficient water resources to local farmers, which can increase their agricultural productivity.

**Geographical Location:** Bukhara and Navoi Provinces.
