Project Goal: Capacity building on NCDs prevention and control at primary health care (PHC) facilities in the target area

Inputs from Uzbek Side:

- ✓ Suitable office space

Activities:

- Baseline survey on the health promotion activities on NCDs such as organization, key-persons, and current activities at community level
- ✓ Baseline survey on current situation of the screening of NCDs (mainly cardiovascular diseases (CDV) and diabetes mellitus (DM)) in the initially intervention rayon
- Trainings health staff in the PHC facilities on the screening of NCDs (mainly CVD and DM)

- ✓ Guidance of nutrition, blood pressure measurement and adherence to the drug therapy including referral cases, for the General Practitioner (GP) and patronage nurse
- ✓ "Journal club" which is gathering to read and discuss papers, articles, books, etc. for studying other countries' experiences and evidences on NCDs

Results (Expected for on-going projects):

- ✓ Capacity of health promotion for NCDs prevention is strengthened.
- Capacity for early detection of NCDs (mainly CVD and DM) at PHC facilities is enhanced.
- Quality of health service (including treatment, counseling by home visit, and referral) to NCDs and risk patients is improved at PHC facilities.
- Capacity on supportive supervision on NCDs is enhanced at Oblast (Province) Health Department.
- Knowledge and experiences through the project activities are visualized and shared.
