Project Goal: Water management conducted by WUAs in Chirchik-Ahangaran BISM and Lower Syrdarya BISM is improved

Inputs from Japanese Side:

- ✓ Dispatching Japanese Experts,
- ✓ Provision of Equipment,
- ✓ Training of Counterparts in Uzbekistan and Japan,
- ✓ Provision of construction works in selected pilot WUAs

Inputs from Uzbek Side:

- ✓ Counterpart personnel,
- ✓ Provision of Land, Building and Facilities,
- ✓ Allocation of operational costs for the Project (staff's salary, utilities at offices, etc.)

Activities:

- ✓ Select pilot WUAs after surveying the situations of WUAs in the regions.
- ✓ Conduct detailed baseline survey for the selected pilot WUAs
- ✓ Prepare training materials (e.g. manuals for WUA, teaching materials for training of trainers (ToT))
- ✓ Conduct a series of ToT for the staff of BISMs and ISDs and leaders of pilot WUAs
- ✓ Understand the current situation of water distribution and analyze the problems and support the formulation of a plan of water distribution and plan for maintenance of irrigation and drainage systems through trainings
- ✓ Supply training equipment and conduct minor repair works

Results:

- ✓ Training system for WUAs is strengthened.
- ✓ Capacity of pilot WUA staff for water distribution is improved.
- ✓ Capacity of pilot WUA staff for maintenance of irrigation and drainage system is improved.

Geographical Location: Tashkent, Syrdarya and Jizzakh Provinces. Target groups: 6 pilot WUAs (2 from each province)
