Project Goal: Nursing education based on "client-oriented nursing" (CON) is innovated in 54 medical colleges throughout the country

Inputs from Japanese Side:

- ✓ Dispatch of Experts: Long-term 5, Short-term 103
- ✓ Facilities and equipment for more than US\$ 300,000
- ✓ Training in Japan: 39 persons

Inputs from Uzbek Side:

- ✓ Counterpart personnel
- ✓ Suitable office space
- ✓ Available data and information related to the Project

Activities:

- ✓ Establish Nursing Education Center at First Republican Medical College (FRMC)
- ✓ Prepare the syllabus and teaching materials on seven subjects (Fundamental Nursing, Maternal Nursing and Child Nursing, Adult Nursing and Gerontology Nursing, Community Nursing and Nursing Management) based on CON
- ✓ Prepare drafts of laboratory manuals for the equipment
- ✓ Hold a seminar on the concept of "client-oriented nursing"
- ✓ Draw up the program for introducing client-oriented nursing education using the prepared curriculum and teaching materials
- ✓ Train nursing educators (ToT) from 54 medical colleges and 6 institutes of medicine for introducing client-oriented nursing education

Results:

- ✓ Teaching Programs of the all seven subjects were approved.

- ✓ Teaching Guidelines of “Fundamental Nursing”, “Adult Health Nursing”, “Gerontological Nursing”, “Child Health Nursing”, “Maternal Health Nursing”, “Community Health Nursing” “Psychiatric Nursing” were completed.
